Neumann and Ole Wæver, eds., *The Future of International Relations: Masters in the Making?* (1996); and featured in Martin Griffiths, Steven C. Roach and M. Scott Solomon, *Fifty Key Thinkers in International Relations*, 2nd ed. (2009).

This powerful collection of essays clarifies Onuf's approach to international relations and makes a decisive contribution to the debates in IR concerning theory. It embeds the theoretical project in the wider horizon of how we understand ourselves and the world.
